2. Her family was poor so they denied her joining the convent, but she remains steadfast in her desire.

Joining the Congregation



3. In 1925 she joins the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady Of Mercy.

Simple Service.



4. She leads a life of humble service as a cook, gardener and porter in various convents.



5. Divine Revelations Begin.



5. Jesus appears to her as Divine Mercy and asks her to paint a picture of HIM.

6. Spreading the Message.



6. She faithfully records Jesus' words about His immense Mercy in her Diary.

7. Painting the Divine Mercy Image



7. With the help of her spiritual director, the image was painted by a man from Vilnius and displayed.

8. The Chaplet of Divine Mercy.



8. Jesus reveals the powerful Chaplet of Divine Mercy and promises grace for those who recite it.



9. The Feast of Divine Mercy



9. Jesus instructs her to establish the Feast of Divine Mercy on the First Sunday after Easter.

10. Illness and Suffering



10. Faustina suffers severe illness and spiritual trials with patience and offers her pain for the salvation of souls.

11. Death of the Saint



11. St. Faustina passes away at the age of 33 on October 5, 1938, in Kraków, Poland deeply united with God in the Mercy

12. Saint of Mercy



Feast Day: October 5

12. She was canonized as the first Saint of the Millennium (2000) by Pope John Paul II.
