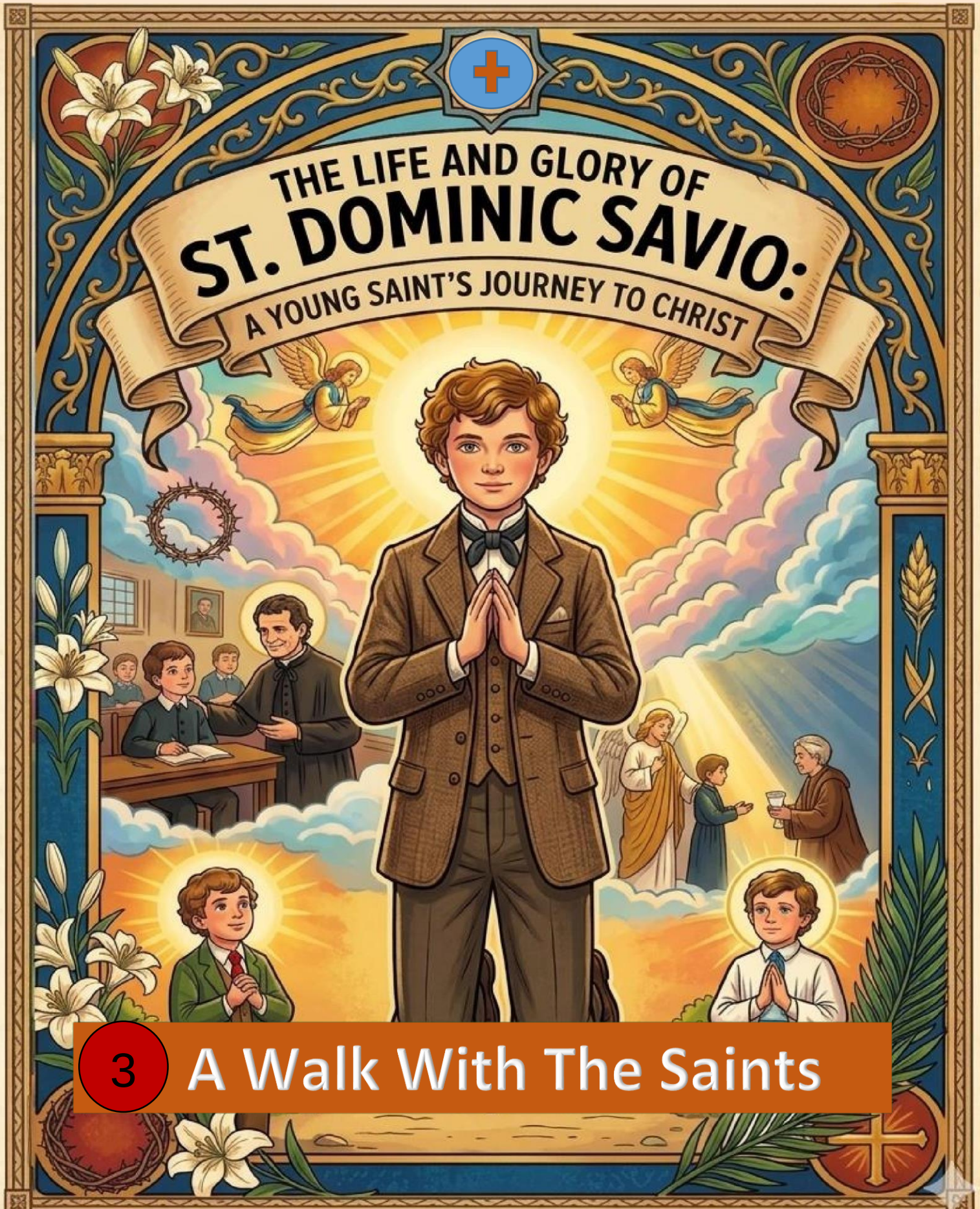

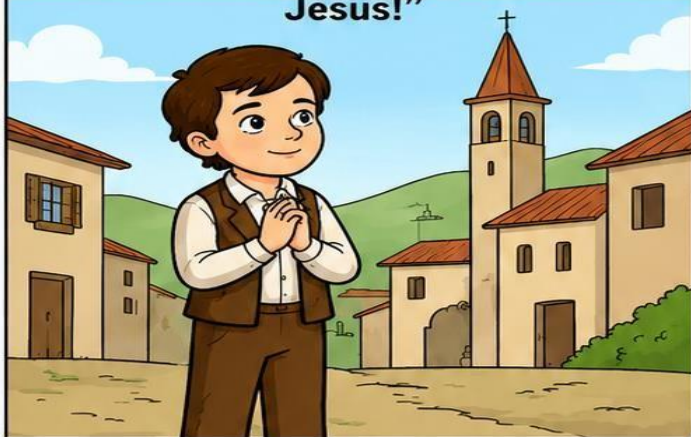

Dominic: “I died at 14, but my story didn’t end. Now, I’m your friend in heaven!”



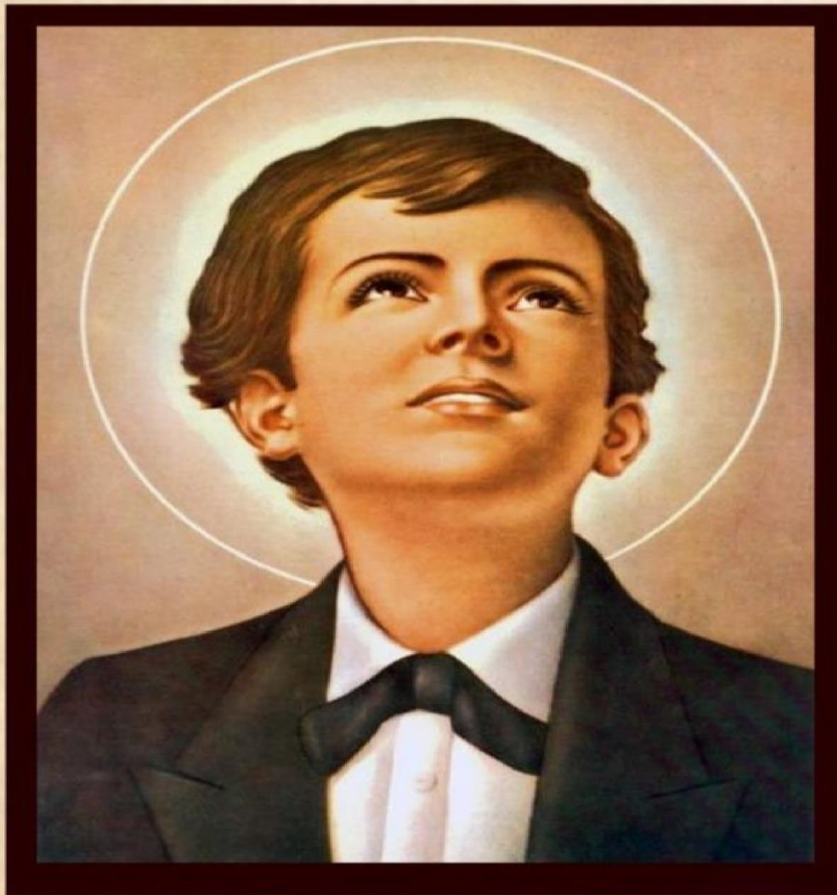
